

<p>This proposed Project consists of the revisions to several sections of RAP's current Schedule of Rates and Fees for services, permits, and facility rentals. The rates for permitting both indoor and outdoor amenities at various recreation centers and venues were last reviewed and approved in 2019.</p> <p>As the cost of providing services to the public continues to grow, and with significant increasing inflation, RAP remains committed to offering high-quality and affordable recreational opportunities to the residents of the City of Los Angeles and its visitors. However, to sustain this commitment and more accurately recover operational costs, an increase in rates and fees has become necessary. Overall, the current rates and fees were found to be below cost recovery levels when compared to those of neighboring municipalities, although certain rates and fees were comparable to other municipalities and were not increased.</p> <p>Beneficiaries of the project are the patrons of the park system.</p>
