SALARY: \$26.69/hour (The current salary is subject to change. You may confirm the starting salary with the hiring department before accepting a job offer).

DUTIES: Lead aquatic facility staff; act as a lifeguard; assist in the operation of a municipal pool and is in charge in the supervisor's absence; conduct swimming and lifesaving classes; organize and coach water sports; organize and lead aquatic camp, develop, direct and promote the activities of a municipal swimming pool; and instruct in swimming and lifesaving techniques.

REQUIREMENT(S)/MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

1. EXPERIENCE:

- Two (2) full summer seasons paid experience as a Los Angeles City Lifeguard; and
- Attend all mandatory manager training and maintain an LA City Lifeguard Certification.

2. **AGE:** 18 years of age by May 25, 2026. Proof of age with picture ID **will be required** at the interview.

3. EXAMINATION:

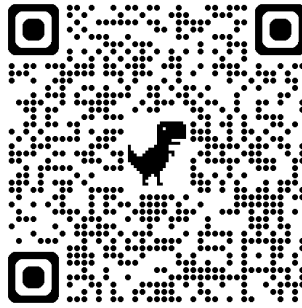
ORAL INTERVIEW: Weighted 100%; a minimum score of 80% is required to be placed on the eligibility list.
