Summer Camp Counselor (Recreation Assistant - Age 18+)

Available Hours: Available Monday -Friday| June 15 – August 14| As early as 7:30 a.m. until 6:30p.m. at the latest. Hours (30-40 hours) may vary depending on the needs of the program. Ability to be available all 8 weeks of camp.

Position Overview: The Summer Camp Counselor is responsible for planning, leading, and supervising activities for youth participants. Counselors will teach fundamental skills, organize activities and games, and create a fun, safe, and engaging environment while in camp.

This is a leadership role that requires strong communication, organization, and the ability to manage groups in an active outdoor setting.

Duties Performed:

- Plan and lead daily games and activities indoors and outdoors.
- Ensure the safety and supervision of all participants at all times.
- Greet parents/guardians and campers during check-in and check-out; verify authorized pick-up persons.
- Set up and break down equipment (ball carts, cones, etc.)
- Maintain a clean and safe environment by organizing and sanitizing equipment.
- Assist with themed special events, and presentation days.
- Actively engage with campers and serve as a positive role model.
- Participate in daily water play and/or swimming activities (if applicable.)
- Follow all City of Los Angeles Department of Recreation and Parks policies and procedures.
- Arrive on time, prepared, and ready to lead each day.

Qualification:

- Strong leadership skills with the ability to instruct and supervise youth.
- Demonstrate good judgment, professionalism, and a positive attitude.
- Ability to plan and lead structured recreational activities.
- Strong communication skills (both verbal and written)
- Ability to build positive relationships with parents, staff, and participants.
- Provide excellent customer service and represent the Recreation Center professionally.
- Ability to be comfortable working outdoors in varying conditions (sun, heat, courts, water, etc.)
- Have reliable transportation.
