Available Hours: Available 2-3 days a week. Monday-Friday | July 13-September 5, including afternoons, evenings and weekends. Hours (0-20 hours) may vary depending on the needs of the program.

Position Overview: Recreation Instructor is responsible for planning, leading, and supervising activities for youth participants. Counselors will teach fundamental skills, organize activities and games, and create a fun, safe, and engaging environment while in camp.

This is a leadership role that requires strong communication, organization, and the ability to manage groups in an active outdoor setting.

Duties Performed:

- Developing and implementing lesson plans in a certain discipline.
- Ensure the safety and supervision of all participants at all times.
- Set up and break down equipment (ball carts, cones, etc.)
- Maintain a clean and safe environment by organizing and sanitizing equipment.
- Actively engage with students and serve as a positive role model.
- Follow all City of Los Angeles Department of Recreation and Parks policies and procedures.
- Arrive on time, prepared, and ready to lead each day.

Qualification:

- Strong leadership skills with the ability to instruct and supervise youth.
- Demonstrate good judgment, professionalism, and a positive attitude.
- Ability to plan and lead structured recreational activities.
- Strong communication skills (both verbal and written)
- Ability to build positive relationships with parents, staff, and participants.
- Provide excellent customer service and represent the Recreation Center professionally.
- Ability to be comfortable working outdoors in varying conditions (sun, heat, courts, water, etc.)
- Have reliable transportation.
