**RECOMMENDATIONS**

1. Adopt the Fiscal Year (FY) 2025-26 Personnel Resolution herein included as an Attachment, effective July 1, 2025; and,
2. Authorize the regular, one-time, as-needed, civil service half-time, substitute, in-lieu, special funded, golf, 120-day positions, and hiring hall positions for FY 2025-26 as listed in the FY 2025-26 Personnel Resolution.

**SUMMARY**

The Board of Recreation and Parks Commissioners establishes the Department of Recreation and Parks (RAP) employment authority on an annual basis through the Personnel Resolution.

RAP's Fiscal Year (FY) 2025-26 Personnel Resolution will authorize 1,448 regular positions (including 59 positions which salaries will be reimbursed by the Harbor Department); 5 unpaid, voluntary Commissioner positions; 84 substitute positions; in-lieu positions; 142 positions funded by the golf operations fund; and 163 positions funded by special funding sources other than the golf operations fund.

In addition, RAP's FY 2025-26 Personnel Resolution will authorize a total of 88 half-time civil service positions; 13 one-time positions subject to renewal on an annual basis, 22 120-day positions, 36 classifications (some of which have multiple pay grades or salary rates) that may be used to employ as-needed employees, and 26 classifications (some of which have multiple pay grades or salary rates) that may be used to employ hiring hall craft employees.

The following is a summary of positions authorized for FY 2025-26.

**SECTION 2: MISCELLANEOUS, INCLUDING IN-LIEU AUTHORITY, FILLING VACANT POSITIONS, AND ADOPTION OF LOS ANGELES ADMINISTRATIVE CODE SECTION 4.61**

1. Upon the approval of the General Manager of the Department of Recreation and Parks, a greater number of persons than specified in this Personnel Resolution for any position classification may be employed therein only to the extent, however, that at no time should the total number of persons employed exceed the total number of positions herein authorized.
2. The Personnel Authority contained in this resolution shall be limited by the amount of money available on the records of the Controller of the City of Los Angeles for the payment of salaries and wages in the Department of Recreation and Parks.
3. The General Manager of the Department of Recreation and Parks shall have the authority to fill each and every vacated position in the Department of Recreation and Parks at such time and in such manner as to the best advantage of the Department of Recreation and Parks.
4. The General Manager of the Department of Recreation and Parks shall have the authority to abolish regular, as-needed, substitute, in-lieu, special funded, and hiring hall positions, as established by the Board of Recreation and Park Commissioners in the Personnel Resolution, that the General Manager deems necessary in order to meet the fiscal and management requirements that develop during the 2025-26 fiscal year.
5. The General Manager of the Department of Recreation and Parks shall have the authority to correct any clerical, typographical, or printing errors in this document.
6. The General Manager of the Department of Recreation and Parks shall have the authority to approve Saturday, Sunday, and holiday work as part of a regular workweek.
7. The General Manager of the Department of Recreation and Parks shall have the authority to enter into work-study program agreements with approved colleges and universities provided the Department of Recreation and Parks is reimbursed for a portion of the salary paid to students in the work-study program.
8. The compensation plan for employees of the Department of Recreation and Parks as contained in Section 4.61 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code (LAAC), including the "Salary Notes Specific to the Recreation and Parks Department," shall apply during the 2025-26 fiscal year.

**SECTION 3: MEMORANDA OF UNDERSTANDING**

Memoranda of Understanding approved by the City Council shall be considered to be incorporated into this Resolution where appropriate. Salaries established under approved Memoranda of Understanding shall apply to all classes of employees therein noted. The provisions of each of the Memoranda of Understanding shall take precedence over any conflicting provision contained in this Resolution but only for those employees in classes within Units to which various Memoranda of Understanding apply.
