SUMMARY

The Greek Theatre Advisory Committee (GTAC) is an eleven-member advisory panel charged with receiving information and making recommendations to the Department and venue management operator regarding the Greek Theatre's programming, operations, community relations, traffic and cultural development. The Board of Recreation and Park Commissioners (Board) approves the appointments of each GTAC Member as recommended by the Department of Recreation and Parks General Manager. The GTAC appointments being presented herein for the Board's approval shall fill four currently vacant seats. Appointments will start on January 1st, 2026, for terms expiring on December 31st, 2028 in accordance with the GTAC Bylaws.
