Important Paperwork

To ensure the safety of all participants and maintain accurate records, please submit the necessary required paperwork before the start of the camp week your child(ren) will be attending.

This mandatory documentation helps us confirm we have all the correct information on file for your camper.

*Age Groups:

Group 1: Ages 5-6

Group 2: Ages 7-9

Group 3: Ages 9.5-12

*Note: Age groups vary by total amount of kids enrolled. 10 kids max per group.

Important Rules

*Emergency Contacts and Pickup:

Parents/Guardians must provide current business or daytime phone numbers for all authorized individuals who may pick up the child. All changes or additions to the authorized pickup list must be completed in person without exception.

*Medical History: Please ensure that we have up-to-date information regarding your child's medical history, including any allergies, illnesses, or current medications.

*Illness Policy: DO NOT send your child if he/she is sick.

*Clothing Guidelines: For safety during playtime, all campers must wear closed-toed shoes only; Crocs are not permitted. Please also ensure your child is dressed in appropriate clothing for active play and is capable of dressing and undressing themselves when necessary, as staff and other campers are unable to provide assistance.

*Discipline Policy: 3 strike rule for bad behavior.

1st strike: The staff will speak directly with the child about the behavior.

2nd strike: The staff will speak with both the parent/guardian and the child.

3rd strike: The camper may be dismissed from the program.
