Beach Days / Water Days on Tuesdays

Additionally, campers must wear their camp shirt to participate in field trips. We cannot take a camper on a trip without their shirt.

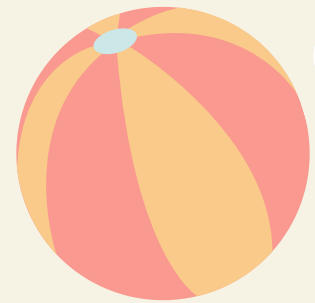
Pool Days/Water Days on Thursdays
