C.I.T. PROGRAM

Ages 14-17

CAMP DATES: June 8 - August 7, 2026

No camp on Friday, June 19th and Friday, July 3rd - Juneteenth and Independence Day

- The Counselor in Training (C.I.T.) program is a youth leadership opportunity designed to prepare participants for potential staff roles. Throughout the program, participants develop essential workplace skills, including leadership, responsibility, and organization. Participants gain hands-on experience by leading games, supervising campers, assisting with crafts, and contributing to a positive camp environment. The program includes an application process, an interview, and completion of a required training prior to the start of summer.
- There is a \$35 fee each week. Payments must be paid by the Wednesday prior to the week. This fee is mandatory even if the CIT does not attend the field trip. The fee for Week 5 is \$110 due to the cost of Universal Studios.
- Participation in the program does not guarantee employment.
- Participants must wear the provided CIT shirt every day.
- Apply by obtaining a CIT application and returning it as soon as possible. CITs must complete an interview and will be informed if they have been selected for the program. There is limited spaces.
- CITs will receive a weekly schedule. Please coordinate with the Camp Director any limitations or schedule conflicts throughout the Summer. Reasonable accommodations to these schedules will be attempted.
