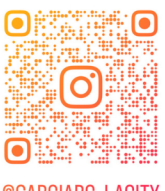

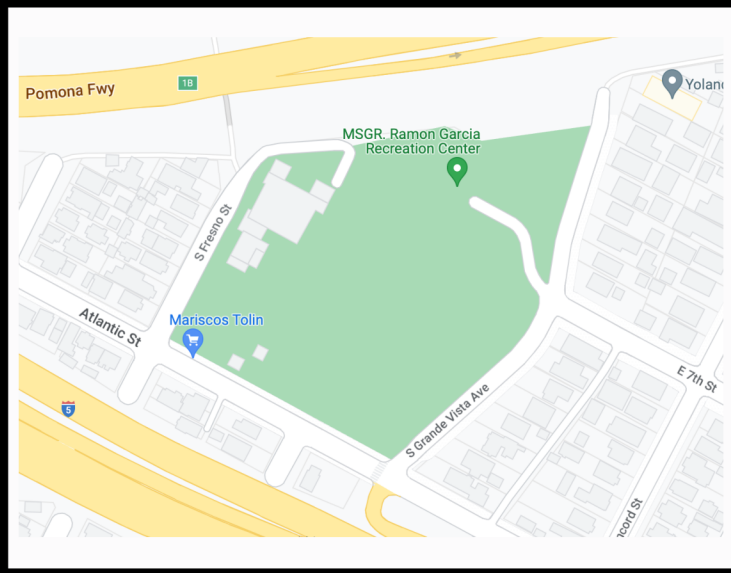

Registration Information

Full payments are required at the time of registration. A participant is not considered registered until full payment has been received. Payments may be made by cash, checks, or credit card (Visa or Mastercard only). When paying in cash, please have the exact amount. Recreation staff cannot make change. Please make checks payable to: **City of Los Angeles Dept. of Recreation & Parks**. A \$35 collection fee will be charged for each returned check. Administration may cancel or combine activities if minimum enrollment is not met. Class times and dates are subject to change.

Refund Policy

You may request a refund before the program's scheduled first day. A 15% administrative fee will be deducted from all refunds. Full refunds are only given if the recreation center cancels a class or program. There will be no refunds after the program begins unless the recreation center changes or cancels a class or sports league.

Please allow 6-8 weeks for the processing of all refund requests.

Facility usage permits are available for anyone (over 18 years old) interested in using the facility for meetings or personal usage such as birthday parties, baby showers, and/or community events. Request must be made at least 4-6 weeks prior to the event. Facility rental payments may be made by cash, checks/money order, or credit card (Visa or Mastercard only) and all fees must be paid in full at least 2 weeks prior to the start of the event.

The cost for each Class and Clinic is \$10.



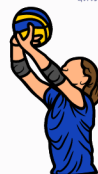

YOUTH EMPLOYMENT INTERNSHIP PROGRAM (Y.E.I.P.)
THIS PROGRAM PROVIDES PRAGMATIC LIFE SKILLS, VALUABLE FOR FACILITATING A YOUTH'S TRANSITION INTO LIFE AFTER HIGH SCHOOL. THE YEIP PROGRAM STARTS A NEW TRACK FOUR TIMES PER YEAR. THE LIFE SKILLS INSTRUCTION IS COMPLEMENTED BY LEADERSHIP TRAINING:
(1) CAMP COUNSELING
(2) OUTDOOR EDUCATION
(3) CRIME SCENE INVESTIGATION

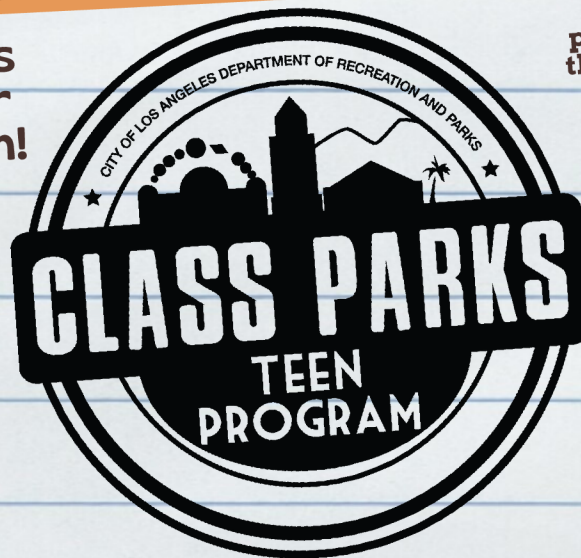
