REGISTRATION INFORMATION & FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

FOR REGISTRATION YOU WILL NEED:

A copy of birth certificate or other proof of age may be required.

Registration fee due in full at time of registration.

Visa and MasterCard accepted. If paying with cash, please bring exact change.

Checks or Money Orders payable to CITY OF LOS ANGELES.

A collection fee will be charged for each returned check.

Personal insurance is not provided by the CITY OF LOS ANGELES.

Volunteer Coaches needed. If interested, come into the office for information on registration and fingerprinting.

LEAGUE INFORMATION & FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:.

REFUND POLICY: You may request a refund before the program's scheduled first day. A 15% administrative fee will be assessed for any patron granted a refund. Full refunds will not be issued unless a class or sports league is cancelled by the recreation center. There will be **NO REFUNDS** after the program has begun unless a class or sports league is changed or cancelled by the recreation center. Refunds take 6-8 weeks to process.

EVALUATIONS: It is important that all players attend evaluations. Coaches and staff will evaluate players. EVERYONE WILL BE PLACED ON A TEAM. The purpose is to evaluate players in order to establish balanced teams. If you register late, you must attend make-up evaluations.

CARPOOL, SIBLINGS & REQUESTING A COACH: Carpool requests will not be accepted. Siblings will be placed on the same team unless otherwise requested. Players may not request a specific coach. Players are DRAFTED and are not guaranteed to be placed on any specific team.

PRACTICES: At this time, it is not known which days or times your child's team will practice. Weekday practices are typically scheduled between 5pm and 9pm and Saturday between 9am and 5pm. Practice times may vary each week. At this time, game times and days have not been determined. Refunds will not be issued if your child cannot make practices or games.

GAMES: The start of the season is tentatively scheduled for October 4, 2025. Teams will usually play one game per week. Occasionally there are weekday games and/or 2 games per week. Game times on weekdays are usually between 5:30pm and 9pm. Saturday game times are between 9am and 8pm. Game time may vary each week. At this time, game times and days have not been determined. League is tentatively scheduled to end November 22, 2025.

UNIFORMS: Uniforms are preordered so players might not receive size requested. We will do our best to match your child up with a comparable size uniform but uniform size cannot be guaranteed.

GENERAL INFORMATION: Your child's coach will be contacting you. If you do not receive a call before **September 22, 2025** please call the recreation center. Please do not call the center prior to that date regarding your child's practice. We would like to give your coach the opportunity to speak to you first. Your coach will hold a parent meeting and give you all he information regarding your child's team and practice times. PLEASE REMEMBER all coaches are volunteers and without them your child would not be able to participate.

TRAVELING: Teams may be required to travel to other recreation centers or schools for games.

PICTURE DAY: Picture day will be listed on the league schedule. Pictures are optional and are not included in the price of registration. Pictures will be handed out to coaches upon delivery. ANY PICTURES NOT COLLECTED ON THIS DAY MUST BE PICKED UP WITHIN TWO WEEKS AT THE RECREATION CENTER OFFICE. YOSEMITE RC WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY PICTURES NOT COLLECTED.

AWARDS: Participation medals will be given to each player who completes the season. Medals will be handed out by coaches at last game of the season. ANY AWARDS NOT COLLECTED ON THIS DAY MUST BE PICKED UP WITHIN TWO WEEKS. THE RECREATION CENTER WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY AWARDS NOT COLLECTED.

ALL STARS: At the conclusion of the season, coaches along with staff will select players in each eligible age division at the recreation center to participate in the all star team. Those players selected will play in a post season all star tournament, which will require additional fees. All-star participants are selected based on skills, sportsmanship, and their efforts during the season, and/or their character both on and off the court. Selected players must meet the all star eligibility requirements set by the Metro Region and Citywide Sports Board. THERE WILL NOT BE POSTSEASON TOURNAMENTS FOR MIGHTY MITE AND PEEWEE.

ALL STAR COACH: Is at the discretion of center staff and league administrators. The selection of the all star coach will take into account character, sportsmanship, trustworthiness and respect.
