If you or your organization has four (4) or more teams, please contact the Municipal Sports Office about creating a Semi-Independent League.

In addition to the registration fee of \$431 there is a \$20 (cash) per game/per team fee for the umpire. This fee is paid prior to the game directly to the umpire, in cash. Teams are responsible for bringing exact change when paying the \$20 umpire fee. Forfeits must be called in to our office by 4pm and fees must be paid prior to the next game.

MAKE CHECKS PAYABLE TO: “L.A. CITY RECREATION & PARKS.” FEES DUE AT REGISTRATION!

ACCEPTABLE FORMS OF PAYMENT: Money Order, Check, or Credit Card. (Visa & Mastercard only)

IMPORTANT: If paying by Credit Card, we need the last group of numbers on the back of your card and the billing zip code.

WAITING LIST PROCEDURE: All teams registering after January 30, 2026, may submit a completed registration form (no fees). If you are offered a slot, and you accept it, no changes can be made. Email, Mail, or fax to Valley Municipal Sports Office (above).

LEAGUE ORGANIZATION: Your team will be placed in a league (usually a league consists of 4-7 teams), on a specific night or Sunday morning, at a specific park(s). Weeknight game times will vary weekly between 7:30pm and 9:30pm; 9:30am, 11:00am, 12:30pm, & 2:00pm on Sundays. Traditionally, there are 12 league games played over 15 weeks (adjusting for holidays). Due to the increased number of regular season games and time constraints, games (e.g. rain-outs, suspensions, etc.) may not be rescheduled. Leagues will have a 2-team playoff at the end of the season to determine the league champion. (Subject to change)

HOLIDAYS: May 10 (Mother’s Day), May 22-25 (Memorial Day Weekend), June 19 (Juneteenth), July 3-5 (July 4th Weekend)

ROSTERS: All softball players who participate in league games must sign a team roster. Rosters are due in the Sports Office prior to the third week of the season. Teams that do not have their roster in by the fourth week of the season will only get one point (instead of the normal two) for a win starting with week four’s game and lasting until they turn in a legal roster. Rosters are not accepted after the 6th week of the season. The Sports Office reserves the right to classify players.

COMMUNICATION: Telephone numbers (and email addresses where applicable) for Team Managers and Assistant Managers must be kept up-to-date. If managers cannot be contacted – the game will be forfeited.
